What is it? The term translation is used to describe the expression of a written text that has been produced in one language, in another language. Interpreting refers only to oral translation. Both translating and interpreting entail communicating in different languages and mediating between different cultures.

The main working foreign languages in this degree are English and French. English is the most widely spoken language worldwide and is used both by its native speakers and by many people as a lingua franca. French is an official language not only in several European countries but also in much of Africa and America.



What can I do with this degree? You will be trained as a non-specialist translator and interpreter, able to take on a wide variety of tasks related to your working languages: English and French, and to address various communication issues. We will mainly prepare you to transform and transmit written and oral messages in order to overcome language barriers originating among speakers of these languages and cultures in different situations. Moreover, an excellent command of Spanish and your other working languages will allow you to carry out different tasks which require an expert in communication.



Can I take part in international student programmes? You can take part in national and international mobility and cooperation programmes, some specific to the ULPGC, which will enhance your training and language skills. In addition to those offered by the degree, you will have other resources for language learning through the Aula de Idiomas, the Confucio and King Sejong Institutes and the free resource platform for self-learning, *CRAAL*.

What career opportunities does it open? We train you for the following professional profiles:

- Non-specialist professional translator
- Linguistic and cultural mediator
- Liaison interpreter
- Editorial reader, editor, proofreader or reviewer
- Lexicographer, terminologist and language project manager
- Intercultural consultant
- Language teacher
